

# Governing Body Panels

Cathy has over 20 years' experience as a school governor and chair of governors in both maintained schools and academies, at primary and secondary levels. She supports chairs of governors as a National Leader of Governance and is an experienced trainer for governors and clerks. Cathy has sat on and chaired a range of panels and advises governors and staff in her Trust on conducting panel hearings.

Governing bodies are required to convene panels for a range of purposes and there is usually a tight timescale to do so. It is recommended that governing bodies have a group of governors who are trained on panels and so are ready when needed.

- *Types of panels, including Exclusions, Complaints, Staff Discipline and Dismissal, Staff Grievance and Pay Appeal*
- When you need to convene panels
- What guidance, regulations and policies govern panel hearings
- Practical issues of setting up and administering panel hearings
- The sorts of questions you should ask
- What decisions you can make
- What happens if there is an appeal
