

New and Reformed National Professional Qualifications (NPQs)



What are NPQs?

NPQs are the most widely recognised qualifications in the education sector for current and aspiring leaders. Accredited by the DfE, NPQs provide training and support for teachers and leaders at all levels. From those who want to develop expertise in high quality teaching practice, such as behaviour management, to those leading multiple schools across a trust.

Teach First are one of a select group of national providers, chosen to design, deliver and assess the reformed NPQs, in collaboration with delivery partners like the Leicester & Leicestershire Teaching School Hub.

What types of NPQs are there?

There are now three specialist NPQs for teachers and leaders who want to broaden and deepen their expertise in specific areas:

NPQ in Leading Teaching (NPQLT) - for subject leads, Key stage leads and department heads. £840

NPQ in Leading Behaviour and Culture (NPQLBC) - for those with Head of Year and pastoral responsibilities. £840

NPQ in Leading Teacher Development (NPQLTD) - for roles such as CPD or ITT lead. £840

For those looking to progress into senior leadership and beyond, the following NPQs build foundational knowledge to rapidly progress your school or trust's key improvement priorities—all while creating and embedding a culture that allows your school, staff and pupils to thrive:

NPQ in Senior Leadership (NPQSL) £1,045

NPQ in Headship (NPQH) £1,690

NPQ in Executive Leadership (NPQEL) £3,245

Each programme is tailored to your school's individual needs and designed to address your daily challenges. This will not only unlock your potential as a leader, but will unlock your pupil's potential too.
